Menstrual Equity for All Act of 2021 Assembly Bill 367
Assembly Bill (AB) 367 was signed by the Governor on October 8, 2021 and enacts the Menstrual Equity for all Act of 2021. On or before the start of the 2022-23 school year, a public school, including a school operated by a school district, county office of education, or charter school, maintaining any combination of classes from grades 6 to 12, inclusive, shall stock the school's restrooms at all times with an adequate supply of menstrual products, available and accessible, free of cost, in all women's restrooms and all-gender restrooms, and in at least one men's restroom.
